RENOWNED ARCHITECTS SNØHETTA EXPAND OMAHA'S JOSLYN ART MUSEUM.

GRAVITY-DEFYING swoops have become a signature of Snøhetta, the daring architects behind Oslo Opera House and Egypt's Bibliotheca Alexandrina. At the newly expanded Joslyn Art Museum in Omaha, Nebraska, reopening this fall, Snøhetta has instead gone low and wide, nearly doubling the Joslyn's existing gallery space with its sloping design for the Rhonda & Howard Hawks Pavilion. Inaugural exhibitions include a selection of works by Omaha native Ed Ruscha, part of a recent gift from the artist, and the first reinstallation of the museum's encyclopedic collections in its 93-year history. *Joslyn.org.* —S.M.
